
# Success in primary purpose of increased student achievement

# In the Year 3 and 5 NAPLAN assessments our Year 3 and Year 5 mean/averages are:

- \* Higher than Similar Schools averages in all areas
- \* Above or close to WA Catholic School mean/averages in most areas
- \* Closing the gap to the National Averages, the most difficult comparative







- \* 1% lower than National average for Science
- \* 3% lower than National average for Science Investigation
- \* 1% above National average for Society and Environment
- \* 10.4% above National average for Society and Environment Investigation.
