<u>Census</u>

Tomorrow, Friday 4 August is Census Day with St John's School required to submit information for the State Government Census and Australian Government Department of Education and Training (AGDET) Census. This data collection provides the community and government with information about schools and students in Australia, collecting information on the numbers of students and staff per school, students on a visa, students with disability, indigenous Australian students at a Consus informs part of the Mu School website, giving parents and the

Australian students etc. Census informs part of the My School website, giving parents and the community information about the needs of each school's students. Governments use Census data to calculate funding and create informed and tailored policies for Australian schools. Census reporting is required under the Australian Education Act 2013.

Regular school attendance is vital to help each individual student reach their God-given potential and flourish. This is particularly true for Friday 4 August so that the State and Federal Governments are provided with a true and accurate picture of the students enrolled at St John's School. If your child is absent on Friday 4 August, it is imperative that we receive a written explanation for this absence on the first day he/she returns, for our records. This procedure is vital for our funding and audit purposes. Thank you, in anticipation.

Feast Day of St Mary of the Cross (Mary Mackillop) - Monday 8 August

Mary MacKillop was the first Australian to be declared a saint by the Roman Catholic Church. She was known as Mother Mary of the Cross in her lifetime.

Saint Mary of the Cross was known for her generosity, courage, and sense of giving for others, particularly those on the margins of society. Saint Mary of the Cross was the foundress of the Sisters of St Joseph in Australia. With Father Julian Tenison Woods and her sisters, Saint Mary of the Cross pioneered some of Australia's earliest Catholic schools.

Within five years, the Sisters opened over 40 schools in South Australia with the mission of serving the most disadvantaged and vulnerable children in these communities, before venturing to other states and territories across Australia.

When: 6-7pm, 1st Monday of the month (starting in August)


